WHAT HAPPENED THIS MONTH? ARSF COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AWARD



NSW Bill To Turn Unused Rail Tracks into Cycling & Walking Paths

NSW Parliament has passed a bill allowing regional communities to convert unused rail corridors into walking and riding tracks so that non-operational rail lines can be converted to allow for recreational or tourism uses.

According to the Regional Transport and Roads minister, making it easier to authorise the use of non-operational rail lines for other uses will benefit rural communities and economies. Similar state-funded pilot projects are already creating hundreds of additional jobs while attracting thousands of visitors each year.
