

#### THIS MONTH: WORLD DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC **VICTIMS**

World Day of Remembrance (WDoR) is observed annually on the third Sunday of November. On this day we remember the millions of lives lost on roads across the world as well as commemorate the efforts of all those involved in reducing road trauma such as the justice system, first responders and road safety organisations.

This year's theme is Justice. A serious, fair and consistent justice system is what a road traffic victim and their family members deserve. It also represents a main factor of prevention and this would mean that lessons are learnt from their tragedies so that they may not be repeated.

#### LAW & NEWS UPDATE

**Expanded police powers to stop and** search on public transport

Queensland police will soon have expanded powers to stop and search people using handheld metal detection wands in all Safe Night Precincts, public transport modes and associated public transport infrastructure. It is expected the extension of powers will be rolled out early next year.

A 12-month trial in Gold Coast saw close to 16,800 people wanded and 197 weapons seized. Almost 500 offenders were charged during this trial.
